ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN  
LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the assessment roll for the levy of a special assessment for the construction of sidewalks on Jackson Avenue, New State Street and Merle Street, as confirmed by the council, be and the same hereby is approved; and the property therein listed and assessed is hereby declared to constitute Local Improvement District No. 2 of this town.

SECTION II.

That the amount set opposite each lot or portion of a lot in said roll be, and the same hereby is levied and assessed against such lot or portion of a lot, and is declared to be a lien thereon.

SECTION III.

That said roll be delivered to the town treasurer, and that he proceed to collect the same.
