AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE RIDING OF BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND: - SECTION I.

That it shall be unlawful for any person to ride any bicycle or other vehicle on any sidewalk in the Town.

SECTION II.

Any person violating the preceding section shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00), and not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).
