RESOLUTION R-4814

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING APPLICATION(S) FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) PROJECT TO THE RECREATION AND CONSERVATION OFFICE (RCO) AS PROVIDED IN RCW CHAPTER 79A.15.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has approved a comprehensive plan that includes the Forbes Lake Park Trail project area; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to undertake a WWRP project, which will include land acquisition and/or facility development (the Project); and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the WWRP, state funding assistance needs to be requested to aid in financing the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland considers it in the best public interest to apply for such assistance and complete the Project to be described in the application;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office for funding assistance.
- <u>Section 2</u>. Any fund assistance received shall be used for implementation of the Project.
- Section 3. The City of Kirkland hereby certifies that its share of Project funding is committed and will be derived from the City of Kirkland 2009 2014 Capital Improvement Program Current Revenues.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The City of Kirkland acknowledges that it is responsible for supporting all non-cash commitments to this project should they not materialize. [*if applicable*]
- <u>Section 5</u>. The City of Kirkland is aware that the grant, if approved, will be paid on a reimbursement basis. This means it may only request payment after eligible and allowable costs have already been paid and remitted to its vendors.

- <u>Section 6</u>. The City of Kirkland acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with financial aid from the Recreation and Conservation Funding Board (RCFB) must be placed in use for the funded purpose and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by the City and RCFB.
- <u>Section 7</u>. This resolution becomes part of a formal application to the Recreation and Conservation Office.
- <u>Section 8</u>. The City of Kirkland provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
