ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE STANDING COMMITTEES

OF THE COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That there be appointed by the Mayor the following standing committees of this Council, to-wit:-

Committee on Finance, Committee on Streets.

SECTION II.

Each of said standing committees shall consist of two members of the Council; the first named by the Mayor being Chairman of the committee.

SECTION III.

The standing committees appointed by the Mayor after the passage of this Ordinance shall hold their positions until the second Tuesday in January, 1907; and thereafter the members of such committees shall hold their positions for the period of one year, or until their successors are named by the Mayor,

SECTION IV.

All matters which are germane to the titles of said committees, together with any other matters that the Council shall see fit, shall be referred to the same.

SECTION V.

It shall be the duty of the Chairman of each of the standing committees at each regular meeting, to make a report to the Council upon each and every matter which has been referred to such committee and is undisposedof, unless such committee be granted further time in reference to such matters by the Council.
