ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS FOR THE PRESENTING

AND AUDITING OF DEMANDS AGAINST THE TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That all demands against the Town shall be reduced to filed with the Clerk. They shall be made out in writing and filed with the Clerk. They shall be made out in bill form, and if necessary, an explanatory statement shall accompany the same. The correctness of the claim or demand, and truth of any statement accompanying the same shall be verified by the affidavit of the claimant or his agent. The Clerk shall present all demands thus filed with him, to the Council at the next regular meeting after the same has been filed with him.

SECTION II.

No bill shall be allowed and ordered paid by the Council at the meeting at which the same shall first be presented to the Council, but shall be referred to the Finance committee for investigation, which committee shall report upon the same to the Council not later than at the next regular meeting, unless said committee be given further time by the Council.

SECTION III.

If after the Finance committee shall have reported upon any claim, the Council shall allow the same and order the same paid, then the Clerk shall prepare a warrant, payable to the claimant, for the amount of such demand, upon the Treasurer, which shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Clerk, and shall specify for what purpose the same is drawn, and out of what fund the same is payable, and shall be by the Clerk promptly delivered to the claimant or his agent.
