ORDINANCE NO. 15.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE DUTIES, TERM AND COMPENSATION
OF THE TOWN MARSHAL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the duties of the marshal of this town shall be such as are provided by the laws of the state of Washington for marshals of town or cities of the fourth class; and also such as may hereafter be prescribed by ordinances of this town. It shall also be his duty to preserve peace and order in the town, and in that connection obey and carry out all orders of the Mayor or Council.

SECTION II.

The term of the marshal of this town shall be one year, or until his successor shall be appointed by the Mayor, such term to commence on the second Tuesday in January. The term of the present marshal shall expire on the second Tuesday in January, A. D. 1907.

SECTION III.

The marshal shall be paid a salary of ten dollars per month, payable monthly.

SECTION IV.

A telephone shall be placed in the residence of the marshal at the expense of the town.
