ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT, AND FIXING
THE DUTIES, TERM AND COMPENSATION OF THE
SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to appoint
a Superintendent of Streets of this Town.

SECTION II.

That the duties of the Superintendent of Streets of this Town
shall be such as are provided by the laws of the State of Washington
for such officers of Towns or Cities of the fourth class; and also
such as may be hereafter prescribed by the Ordinances of this Town.
It shall be his duty to look after all the affairs and business of
the Town in reference to its streets, alleys and public places;
to supervise all work of whatsoever kind which may be done upon the
same; and to keep the Council informed as to the condition of the
streets, alleys and public places, and as to all repairs and improve-
ments which should be done upon the same.

SECTION III.

The term of the Superintendent of Streets of this Town shall
be one year or until his successor shall be appointed by the Mayor;
such term to commence on the second Tuesday in January. The term of
the first Superintendent of Streets of this Town shall expire the
second Tuesday in January, 1907.

SECTION IV.

The compensation of the Superintendent of Streets shall be
the sum of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per day for all the
time actually spent by him in working for the Town; for which he shall
render itemized bills to the Council from time to time.
