## ORDINANCE NO. / 7

AN ORDINANCE TO DECLARE THE BUILDING OCCUPIED BY

JOHN A. FERRY, AS NOW USED, A NUISANCE,

AND TO ABATE THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND: SECTION I.

That Whereas it has come to the knowledge of the Council of this Town, that the South half of the building located on the West side of the County road running from Kirkland to Houghton, and immediately South and adjoining the ferry entrance, in the Town of Kirkland, County of King and State of Washington, which is now occupied by one, John A. Ferry, is now being kept and maintained as a place where intoxicating liquors are kept and harbored for the evident purpose of selling and giving away said liquors contrary to law, and where persons are permitted to resort for the purpose of drinking intoxicating liquors, and where intoxicating liquors are kept for the purpose of inducing people to resort to buy and receive intoxicating liquors in violation of law; and

Whereas this Council is informed that said place is thus kept

and maintained by one, John A. Ferry;

HOW THEREFORE, Said South half of said building, as now kept and maintained, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

## SECTION II.

The Town Attorney is hereby directed to notify such persons, if any there be, under whom said Ferry may hold said premises, to forthwith cause said nursance to be abated; and in case of their failure so to do, he shall promptly begin a suit in the Superior Court of King County, in the name of the Cown of Mirkland against said property and said Herry, and such persons as he may hold under, for the purpose of abating said nuisance and enjoining the continuance of the same.
