ORDINANCE NO. 18.

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN LOCAL

IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. I.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1.

That the assessment roll for the levy of a special assessment for the construction of sidewalks on Market street from Lake avenue to Piccadilly and Richmond streets, as confirmed by the concil, be and the same hereby is approved; and the property therein listed and assessed is hereby declared to constitute Local Improvement District No. 1. of this town...

SECTION 2.

That the amount set opposite each lot or portion of a lot in said roll be, and the same hereby is levied and assessed against such lot or portion of a lot, and is declared to be a lien thereon.

SECTION 3.

That said roll be delivered to the town treasurer and that he proceed to collect the same.
