## ORDINANCE NO.19

AN ORDINANCE TO MACATE A PORTION OF FIRST STREET IN THE COMMERCIAL ADDITION TO KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, On the 24 day of April, 1906, there was filed with the Clerk of this Town a petition addressed to the Council, praying

that said Council make vacation of a portion of First Street in the Commercial Addition to Kirkland; and WHEREAS, on the 284 day of April, 1906, said Council passed an order fixing the 21st day of May, 1906, as the time when said petition should be heard and determined by the Council, at its usual place of meeting at the hour of 8 P. M., and directing the Clerk of the Town to give notice of the pendency of said petition and of the hearing thereon, by setting up a notice thereof in the three public posting places heretofore fixed by Ordinance, and in a conspicuous place on the street sought to be vacated,, said notices to be posted at least twenty days before the time set for said hearing; and WHEREAS, The Clerk of this Town has posted said notices

in the manner and within the time directed; and

"MEREAS, At the time and place fixed in said notices, this Council was duly in session, and no objections were made by any person to the granting of said petition, and thereupon the Council determined to grant said petition, the said petition having been signed by all the owners in fee of land abutting upon the portion of a street sought to NOW PHEREFORE, be vacated; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND: SECTION I.

That the portion of a street locatedin said Town, and described as follows, to-wit: All of First Street between the South line of New Hampshire Avenue and the South line of the Commercial Addition to Kirkland; except a strip Twelve (12) feet wide from East to West in the center of the above described part of First Street, said strip extending from the South line of New Hampshire Avenue to the South line of Lot Six (6), in Block Five (5) of said Addition, extended across said First Street; be and the same hereby is vacated. SECTION II.

That said Twelve (12) foot strip above reserved from this vacation shall hereafter be usedas an alley.
