ORDINANCE NO.2/

AN ORDINANCE TO GRANT A TELEPHONE FRANCHISE TO THE SUNSET TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY.

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Kirkland: SECTION 1.

The Town of Kirkland hereby grants unto the Sunset Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation organized under the laws of the state of California, its successors and assigns, the right and privilege to do a telephone business within said Town, and to place, erect, lay maintain and operate in, over, and under the streets, avenues, alleys and highways within said Town, wires and other appliances and conductors for the transmission of electricity for telephone purposes; such wires or conductors may be strung upon poles or other fixtures above ground, or at the option of the said grantee, its successors and assigns, may be laid underground in pipes or conduits, for otherwise protected, and such other apparatus may be used as may be necessary or proper to operate and maintain the same.

SECTION 11.

It shall be lawful for said Company, its successors or assigns, to make all needful and convenient excavations in any of said streets, avenues, alleys and highways for the purpose of erecting and maintaining poles and other supports, or laying pipes or conduits, for said wires. But it shall be the duty of said Company to properly protect cny such excavations, and in case of any accident or injury to any person by reason of any such excavations of said Company shall save and keep harmless said Town from any and all, liability on that account. SECTION 111.

Any and all work done by said Company shall be done with prompt ness and dispatch, and any street, avenue, alley or highway disturbed shall be restored to its original condition.

SECTION 1V.

Be free proceeding to disturb any street, avenue, alley or highway said Company shall file with the Town Clerk a map and specifications of the work intended to be done, and shall get the same approved by the Superintendent of Streets;

but such approval shall not be witheld unless such work will interfere with property of the Town. All work shall be done under the supervision of the Superintendent of Streets. In case of any change in the officers of the Town, this right of supervision and approval is hereby reserved to such officer or officers as may have charge of the streets.

SECTION V.

The Town of kirkland shall have the right to suspend upon the poles of the Company, or lay in its conduits, any and all wires it may hereafter fequire for fire alarm or police telegraph service.

SECTION VI.

Whenever it may be necessary in the opinion of the Town Council to change the location of any pole or ples, the Company shall upon reasonable notice change the same. When such a change is made at the instance of the Town, the Town shall pay the cost of removal, but not be liable for any interference with the business of the Company. SECTION VII.

The charges for telephone service to all persons rediding in the Town shall not exceed the following rates:

Four party Residence \$2.00 per month.

Four party Business 3.50 Per month

Individual Residence 3.00 Per month

Individual Business 6.00 per month.

SECTION VILL.

The Company agrees to be prepared to furnish good telephone service to the residents of the Town within four (4) months after the passage of this ordinance. Such service shall include the whole of the Company's service operated by it in the City of Seattle, and in the matter of service the telephones in this Town shall be conducted as though part of the Company's Seattle telephone system; and no tell or other charges made, except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 1X.

The Company shall furnish to the Town, free of charge, telephones at the Sollowing places:

The residence of the Mayor.

The residence of the Nown Clerk.

The residence of the Nown Warshell

The regular place of meeting of the Council.

The Office of the Town Attorney

SECTION X.

All the terms, conditions and provisions of this ordinance shall be binding on said Company, and its successors and assigns; and for any violation thereof the Town Council may declare the same forfeited. SECTION X1.

Within fifteen (15) days after the passage of this ordinance, the Company shall file with the Town Clerk an acceptance thereof, age be resing to bound by all the terms thereof; and in case of its failure so to do the grant herein contained shall lapse.

SECTION X11.

This grant herein contained shall extend for the period of 25 years from the passage of this ordinance.
