

ORDINANCE NO. 23
AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 22 OF THIS
TOWN, BEING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO
LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT"
DISTRICT NO. ~~2~~ "2"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section I.

That ordinance No. 22 of this town, being an ordinance entitled, "An ordinance to levy a special assessment in Local Improvement District No. 2." be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section II.

That the Town Treasurer is hereby directed to repay any and all amounts collected under the assessment confirmed by said ordinance; or give credit to the person having made any such payment upon any assessment hereafter levied in said District, as such person may elect.

Section III.

That the Committee on Streets report a new assessment roll to the Council in said District.
