ORDINANCE NO. ~~29~~ 30

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPRISONMENT IN THE COUNTY JAIL OF KING COUNTY OF ALL PERSONS LIABLE TO IMPRISONMENT IN CASES BEFORE THE POLICE JUSTICE IN THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND AND ALL CASES ARISING UNDER THE ORDINANCES OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1.

In all cases of which the police court of the town of Kirkland has jurisdiction and in the course of which, either before or after judgment or sentence, it may become lawful and necessary to detain in custody, or imprison any person of which said court has jurisdiction, such imprisonment may be in the County Jail of King County, Washington, provided the consent to such imprisonment therein be first had in a manner prescribed by law.

SECTION 11.

Provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to cases begun prior, as well as to those begun subsequent to the taking effect of this ordinance.
