ORDINANCE NO. 32. ✓

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING MISDEMEANORS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT OF THOSE GUILTY THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1.

The following persons are declared to be guilty of a misdemeanor:

1. Every person who, having no lawful means of support, is wilfully idle; also any person who habitually loiters in or about the public streets or places of the town or is found in any place to the annoyance of the public.
2. Every person who solicits alms as a business.
3. Every gambler, or person who makes a business of playing at games of chance for profit; and every person engaging in gambling, bunco or swindling games or devices for the purpose of swindling or defrauding others.
4. Every person who shall be guilty of fighting, drunkenness or any indecent riotous or disorderly conduct, or any conduct tending to debauch the public morals or to a disturbance of the peace.
5. Every person who shall use any profane, abusive or obscene language, or shall be guilty of any indecent or immoral act or practice in said town, whereby the peace or quiet of the town may be disturbed.
6. Every person who shall threaten or traduce another, or shall use any language or indulge in any conduct toward another tending to produce a disturbance of the peace; or shall challenge another

to fight, or who shall agree with another to fight, or who shall, by agreement, actually fight.

Any person who shall keep any house or place of business and shall suffer or permit therein any loud or boisterous noise to be made therein after the hour of 10 P. M., or to suffer or permit therein at any time any riotous or disorderly conduct, drunkenness or fighting to the annoyance or to the disturbance of the peace, comfort, quietude or decency of the public.

SECTION 11.

It shall be the duty of the Town Marshal to promptly arrest, or cause to be arrested, and inform against all persons whom he shall have reasonable cause to believe guilty of a misdemeanor as above defined.

SECTION 111.

Every person guilty of a misdemeanor so defined in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding 30 days, or by both fine and imprisonment provided the number of dollars fine and three times the number of days imprisonment shall not exceed a total of one hundred.
