

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PERMISSION TO VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS
TO USE NEW HAMPSHIRE AVENUE FOR A SKID ROAD AND
MAKING CERTAIN REGULATIONS IN REGARD
TO SUCH USE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1.

Permission is hereby granted S. E. Courtright, J. S. Courtright, H. A. Eagon, A. R. Cox and M. C. Larson to use New Hampshire Avenue, and Kirkland and Haughton road for for the purpose of a skid road under the direction and inspection of the Committee on Streets. This permit shall be revocable at the pleasure of the city council, but such revocation shall not take effect until thirty (30) days notice has been first given.

SECTION 11.

It is further provided that before the individuals named in Section 1 hereof shall use said street, as above set out, they shall deposit the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars with the Town Clerk to insure that upon the expiration of the privilege hereby granted, said individuals will remove all the skids in said New Hampshire Avenue, and leave said street in as good condition as same was before the placing of said skids in said road.
