ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF PROPERTY FOR PURPOSES OF TAXATION, FOR THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL TAXES AND FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That all property subject to taxation within the corporate limits of the town of Kirkland, be assessed, and that all the general municipal taxes levied by said town shall be collected in the manner provided in an act of the legislature of the State of Washington, entitled: "An act to amend Sections One, Nine and Ten of an act entitled: 'An act to provide for the assessment and collection of taxes in municipal corporations of the third and fourth classes in the State of Washington, and declaring an emergency', approved March 9th, 1893", which said act was approved March 20th, 1895, and which appears in Pierce's Washington Code of 1905, as Sections 8723 to 8732 inclusive.

SECTION II.

That the tax levy for each year for municipal purposes shall be made by the council at the time and in the manner prescribed in the act designated in Section I of this Ordinance, and that the levy for each year shall be evidenced by an Ordinance of the town council.

SECTION III.

That upon the passage of this Ordinance, copies of the same be forwarded by the town clerk to the assessor and treasurer of King County, Washington.
