

ORDINANCE NO. 36,

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN
LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 6

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the Assessment Roll for the levy of special assessments on abutting property, and also on the Town of Kirkland, for the construction of a sidewalk on the west side of Market Street from the south line of Richmond Street to the center line of California Street at its intersection with Market Street, said Roll having been filed with this Council on the 20th day of May, 1907, be and the same hereby is confirmed and approved, and the property therein listed and assessed is hereby declared to constitute Local Improvement District No. 6 of the Town of Kirkland.

SECTION II.

That the amount set opposite each lot or portion of a lot in said Roll is hereby levied and assessed against said lot or portion of a lot and declared a lien thereon, and the amount appearing in said Roll, as the amount required by law to be paid by the town, is hereby declared a just charge against the Town of Kirkland.

SECTION III.

That said Roll be delivered to the Town Treasurer and that he proceed to collect the same in the manner provided by law.
