

ORDINANCE NO. 38

AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT
IN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 8,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I.

That the Assessment Roll for the levy of special assessment on abutting property, and also on the Town of Kirkland to defray the cost of constructing a sidewalk on the Northeast side of Marion Street, and also on the East side of that part of Lake Avenue lying between the Northeast side of Marion Street produced west, and the south line of the Nelson Addition, as ordered by said Town Council on the 23rd day of April, 1907, said roll having been filed with the Town Council of said Town on the 17th day of June, 1907, be, and the same hereby is approved and confirmed and the property therein listed and assessed is hereby declared to constitute Local Improvement District No. 8 of the Town of Kirkland.

SECTION II.

That the amount set opposite each lot or portion of a lot in said roll is hereby levied and assessed against said lot or portion of a lot and declared a lien thereon, and the amount appearing in said Roll as the amount required by law to be paid by the town, is hereby declared a just charge against said Town of Kirkland.

SECTION III.

That said Roll be delivered to the Town Treasurer, and that he proceed to collect the same in the manner provided by law.
