AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF CERTAIN MINORS AT PUBLIC BILLIARD HALLS AND POOL ROOMS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND: -

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of Sixteen (16) years, to play, watch, or be present at, any game of games of billiards or pool, in any room or rooms, hall or halls, tent or tents, booth or booths, or to enter such room, hall, tent, or booth, where said game or games is or are conducted publicly for hire, or advertised to be so conducted, whether such games or games be in process or not.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any proprietor, manager, or agent of such proprietor or manager any place or places where such game or games is or are conducted publicly for hire, or advertised to be so conducted, to allow any game or games of billiards or pool to be so conducted or played at any room or rooms, hall or halls, booth or booths, tent or tents, in which such minor under the age of Sixteen (16) years shall be present; and it shall be unlawful for such proprietor, manager, or agent to allow such minor to enter such room, hall, booth, or tent, whether such game be in process or not.

Section 3. Copies of this ordinance shall be posted in at least two (2) conspicuous places in each room, hall, tent, or booth, where such game or games are so conducted.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this or-
