ORDINANCE 447.

of Automobiles and Motor Vehicles
An Ordinance regulating the rate of speed in the Town of
Kirkland, and Providing a penalty for the
Violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:-

Section 1. No person driving or in charge of any automobile or motor vehicle on any highway, townway, public street, avenue, driveway, or parkway, within the limits of the Town of Kirkland, shall drive the same at a greater rate of speed than 10 miles per hour.

Section 2. No person shall drive any automobile or motor vehicle along the Redmond Road, *faster than 10 miles* so-called, to or from the Kirkland King County Ferry Dock *or any other dock*, to the ~~eastern~~ boundary line of the Town of Kirkland at a greater rate of speed than 5 miles per hour.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in the sum of *ten to fifty* Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding 20 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
