

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE YEAR 1910.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

1. That the amount to be raised by general taxation for municipal purposes by the town of Kirkland for the ensuing fiscal year; that is to say, for the year beginning on the second Tuesday in January, 1910, is hereby fixed in the sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00).
2. That said sum shall be raised by a general tax upon all the real and personal property within the limits of said town subject to taxation.
