

ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 54, entitled; "An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Lake Avenue and the Lakeside Road from the County Road (commonly known as the Kirkland-Redmond Road) at the King County Ferry landing, southerly to the southern limits of the Town of Kirkland, a total distance of about 3250 feet, by constructing a wooden sidewalk on the easterly portion of said street and road, and by constructing the necessary cross walks and box drains, in accordance with Resolution No. 13 of the Town of Kirkland, and providing for the payment thereof by special assessments to be levied in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington and the Ordinances of said Town of Kirkland", passed and approved the 16 day of August, 1909.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:-

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 54 of the Town of Kirkland, entitled, "An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Lake Avenue and the Lakeside Road from the County Road (commonly known as the Kirkland-Redmond Road) at the King County Ferry landing, southerly to the southern limits of the Town of Kirkland, a total distance of about 3250 feet, by constructing a wooden sidewalk on the easterly portion of said street and road, and by constructing the necessary cross walks and box drains, in accordance with Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ of the Town of Kirkland, and providing for the payment thereof by special assessments to be levied in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington and the ordinances of said Town of Kirkland", passed and approved August 16, 1909, be and the same is hereby repealed.
