ordinance no. 67

An Ordinance levying certain assessments in local improvement District No. 16 in the Town of Kirkland.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Kirkland:

Sec.1. That the amended assessment roll heretofore filed with
the Town Council by the street committee showing certain assessments
for the improvement by fill of that part of Piccadilly Street in said
Town of Kirkland lying between blocks 184 and 187 in the map of
Kirkland be and the same hereby is approved and confirmed, and the
various parcels of land described in said roll are hereby declared
to be specially benefitted by said improvement and to constitute
local improvement District No. 16 of said town of Kirkland, and the
amounts set against each parcel of land therein set forth are hereby
declared to represent the special benefit conferred by said improvement upon daid parcels of land, and said amounts are hereby assessed
against the respective descriptions of property against which said
amounts appear, and said amounts are further declared a first lien
against said several descriptions of property.

Sec. 2. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to forward said assessment roll to the town treasurer for the purpose of collecting said assessments in the manner provided by law.
