ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 1. After the passage and approval of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to discharge within the town limits of the Town of Kirkland any pistol, revolver, rifle, shotgun or any fire arm of any kind whatsoever.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not ~~to exceed~~ less than 10.00 nor more than 50.00 Dollars.
