

An Ordinance creating new duties for the Town Marshal, and amending existing ordinances so far as they shall relate to his compensation, or are inconsistent herewith/

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

I.

Section 1. From and after the passage of this ordinance and its approval, the duties of the town marshal of the town of Kirkland, in addition to those now imposed upon him by existing ordinances, shall include the work heretofore ~~now~~ done by the Kirkland Street Commissioner, and he shall have supervision over all streets, alleys, side-walks and highways within the limits of the town, and their repair, construction and maintenance, Subject to the direction of the Mayor and the town Council.

Section 2. The compensation of said town marshal shall be prescribed by the Mayor and council of the town of Kirkland.

II.

Section 1. The duties of the town marshal, newly created by this ordinance; shall include not less than (8) eight hours work each and every working day on the aforesaid streets, alleys and sidewalks.

III.

Section 1. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed so far, and only so far, as they shall be inconsistent with the terms hereof.
