

An Ordinance providing for the improvement of Second Street, as the same appears in the plat of Commercial Addition, from the South line of New Hampshire Avenue to the South line of Kirkland Heights, an Addition to the town of Kirkland, by grading the same.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

I.

That Second Avenue, as the same appears in the Plat of Commercial Addition from the south line of New Hampshire Avenue to the south line of Kirkland Heights Addition to the town of Kirkland, be improved by opening and grading the same in accordance with the grades established by the engineer acting under direction of the city council.

II.

That an assessment to defray the cost of said improvement be levied and collected as by law provided upon all lots and parcels of land benefited by said improvement, excepting the cost of such portion as shall fall within the intersections of streets, which shall be paid out the general fund of the town of Kirkland.

III.

That there is hereby established a local improvement district, which shall be known as District No. 18 and which shall include all of said land so benefitted by said improvement, which said land shall bear all expenses of; and those incidental to, the opening and grading of said street, which said expenses shall become a first lien upon said property.

IV.

That said improvement shall be made by contract to be let to the lowest bidder therefor, as provided by law.
