An ordinance providing for the Grading of Merle Street, in South Kirkland, from the east line of the State Aid Road eastward to the end of said (Merle Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

I.

That Merle Street, in South Kirkland, beginning at the east line of the State Aid Road, and running thence eastward to the end of said Merle Street, be improved by grading the same in accordance with the grades established by the engineer acting under direction of the town council.

II.

That an assessment to defray the cost of said grading be levied upon all lots and parcels of land benefitted by said grading, as by law provided, excepting the cost of such portion as shall fall within the intersections of streets; which shall be paid out of the general fund of the town of Kirkland.

III.

That there is hereby established a local improvement district, which shall be known as District No. 20 and which shall include all of said land so benefitted by said grading, which said land shall bear all expenses of, and tose incidental to, the grading and surveying said street, which said expense shall become a first lien upon said property.

IV.

That said grading shall be done by contract, to be let to the lowest bidder as by law provided.
