ORDINANCE NUMBER 827

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE EAST SIDE NEWS THE OFFICIAL  
NEWSPAPER FOR THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND;

Be it ordained by the council of the town of Kirkland, King  
County, State of Washington;

That the East-side News, a weekly newspaper published in the town of  
Kirkland and a newspaper of general circulation therein, be and the  
same is hereby designated the Official Newspaper for said town of  
Kirkland, and any and all ordinances, notices, and other matters  
requiring publication shall be published for two successive issues  
therein which, when so published, shall constitute due and legal  
notice.

Merchantile Company, situated near the ferry Deck  
in the town of Kirkland, and near the junction of the  
Houghton and Redmond Roads.
