ORDINANCE NO...

An ordinance levying certain assessments in local improvement District No18 in the town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section (1)

That the amended assessment roll heretefore filed with the town council by the street committee showing certain assessments for the opening and grading of Second Street, as the same appears in the plat of commercial addition, from the South line of New Hampshire Avenue to the South line of Kirkland Heights, an addition to the town of Kirkland, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and the various parcels of land described in said roll are hereby declared to be specially benefitted by said improvement and to constitute local improvement District No18 of the said town of Kirkland, and the amounts set against each parcel of land therein set forth are hereby declared to represent the special benefit conferred by said improvement upon said parcels of land, and said amounts are hereby assessed against the respective descriptions of the property against which said amounts appear, and said amounts are further declared a first lien against said several descriptions of property.

Section (2)

The town clerk is hereby directed to foward said assessment roll to the town treasurer for the purpose of collecting said assessments in the manner provided by law.
