

ORDINANCE NO. 80...

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE YEAR 1912.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:
Section (1)

That the amount to be raised by general taxation for municipal purposes by the town of Kirkland for the year beginning on the second Tuesday in January A.D. 1912, is hereby fixed in the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Five (\$2,765.00) Dollars, being the amount necessary and required to meet the public expenses of said Town of Kirkland for the ensuing year as shown by the itemized estimates of the contemplated expenditures heretofore made on the 28th day of August A.D. 1911, published in the official Paper, and approved this 2nd day of October A.D. 1911.


Section (11)

That the said sum of (\$ 2765.00), shall be raised by a general tax upon all the real and personal property within the corporate limits of said town of Kirkland subject to taxation.
