

ORDINANCE NO. 81..

An ordinance levying certain assessments in local improvement District No 20 in the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

Section (1)

That the amended assessment roll heretofore filed with the town Council of the Town of Kirkland by the street committee showing certain assessments for the opening and grading of Merle Street, in South Kirkland, from the east line of the State aid road eastward to the end of said Merle Street, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and the various parcels of land described in said roll are hereby assessed and declared to be specially benefitted by said improvement and to constitute local improvement District No. 20 of said town of Kirkland, and the amounts set opposite and against each parcel of land therein set forth are hereby declared to represent the special benefit conferred by said improvement upon said parcels of land, and said amounts are hereby assessed against the respective descriptions of the property against which said amounts appear, and said amounts are further declared a first lien against said several descriptions of property.

Section (11)

The town clerk is hereby directed, to forward said assessment roll to the town Treasurer for the purpose of collecting said assessments in the manner provided by law.
