

Ordinance No. *87*.

An ordinance repealing ordinance No 43 of the town of Kirkland entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PRESENCE OF CERTAIN MINORS AT PUBLIC BILLIARD HALLS AND POOL ROOMS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF."
