AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the running at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Kirkiand of any horse, mule, cow or other animal from the hour of seven o'clock P. M. until the hour of six o'clock A. M. with a bell or any other noise-making device fastened to the neck or any other part of said animal, and providing a penalty for the violation of this Ordinance.
