

ORDINANCE NO. 91

An ordinance amending section XIX of ordinance No. 87 (approved December 18, 1911) Entitled: An ordinance, granting to Boone F. Gordon, and Lelia May Gordon, their heirs and assigns, the right, privilege, authority and franchise, to erect, construct and maintain pole and wires over, along, and across the streets, avenues and alleys of the town of Kirkland, and to construct conduits therein for the purpose of the transmission, distribution and sale of electric current for electric power, heat and light and for any other purpose for which electric power, heat and light and for any other purpose for which electricity may be used.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:
AS FOLLOWS:

That Boone F. Gordon and Lelia May Gordon and their assigns, The Kirkland-Redmond Railway, Light and Power Co., a corporation, be granted and they hereby are granted an extension of sixty days time from and after March 1st, 1912, in which to place in operation that electric lighting, heating and power system, the franchise for which was granted by ordinance No. 87 as passed by the council of the Town of Kirkland, and approved by the Mayor thereof, on the 18th day of December, 1911, and that Section XIX of said ordinance No. 87 be amended and it is hereby amended, as to the last clause of said section, so that said clause shall read:

"and will have said system in operation and of sufficient capacity to furnish no less than four hundred (400) sixteen (16) candlepower incandescent lights or its equivalent in wattage on or by sixty days from and after March 1st, 1912."
