an ordinance regulating the position of auto
mobile stages and automobiles carrying
passengers for hire, upon the King County ferry
wharf and requiring all owners and drivers
of said automobiles, to comply with the
provisions of this ordinance and providing
a penalty for the violation of ~~this ordinance~~ thereof.
Be it ordained, by the Council of the
Town of Kirkland,

Section (1)

It shall be unlawful for the owner or
driver of any automobile ~~driver~~ or stage
carrying passengers for hire from the said
King County ferry within the corporate limits
of the town of Kirkland to occupy any other position
upon the said King County ferry wharf than
the following: That is to say the first automobile
or stage to stop upon the ferry wharf for the
purpose of receiving passengers ^{or unseated person having a machine} shall stop his
machine at a point on the north side of said
wharf a distance of 86 feet from the ~~gate~~ King
County ferry gate and that each and every auto
stage and automobile carrying passengers for
hire shall take a position ^{on the north side of said wharf} and be not closer
than four feet nor farther away than six feet
from the automobile in line ~~farther~~ farther from
the said King County ferry gate; That said automobiles
shall take position in line as heretofore mentioned
and be headed away from said gate;

That ~~and~~ any person ^{Section 2} violating any of the provisions of
this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and

shall be subject to a fine in any sum
not exceeding $\$25^{00}$
