

ORDINANCE NO. 111

An ordinance revoking for cause the franchise heretofore granted the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, to use the streets and alleys of the town of Kirkland, for poles, wires, etc., and operate a telephone system therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

1.

That the franchise heretofore, to-wit., on the 25th day of August A. D. 1906, granted to the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation, be, for the reason that said corporation has failed to comply with the terms and conditions thereof, *and further that a bill of sale has been given of its equipment in the town of Kirkland, which has been granted to the Lake Washington Telephone Company, a corporation, and at an end, save and except that said corporation shall have the right and privilege of selling, transferring or otherwise disposing of its telephone poles and equipment to the Lake Washington Telephone Company, a corporation.* *the town of Kirkland has been granted to the Lake Washington Telephone Company, a corporation, and at an end, save and except that said corporation shall have the right and privilege of selling, transferring or otherwise disposing of its telephone poles and equipment to the Lake Washington Telephone Company, a corporation.*
