An Ordinance establishing the dimensions of service water mains for the Town of Kirkland and determining the method of laying and paying for the same.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:

Section 1. Service water mains for the Town of Kirkland shall be of wood pipe, wire bound, with _______ inches between the spiral windings and shall be four (4) inches internal diameter, and properly laid at least two (4) feet below the level of the ground and covered with at least two feet of earth.

Section 2. Whenever it shall be necessary to purchase and lay a service water main along any street an improvement district shall be created by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland and the cost of said service water main shall be assessed to said district so formed, as prescribed in chapter 98, Laws of 1911 of the legislature of the State of Washington.

Section 3. Whenever an eight (8) inch or ten (10) inch main shall be purchased or laid along any street in said Town of Kirkland the Town of Kirkland shall pay the cost thereof over and above the cost of purchasing and laying a four (4) inch internal diameter, water main along said street, which cost shall be paid from a fund to be created for that purpose by the Town 61 Kirkland under proper ordinance.
