ORDINANCE NO. 118

1 An Ordinance establishing the dimensions of service water mains  
2 for the Town of Kirkland and determining the method of laying and  
3 paying for the same.

4 BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:

5 Section 1. Service water mains for the Town of Kirkland shall  
6 be of wood pipe, wire bound, with <sup>as required by specifications of the Engineer</sup> ~~with~~ inches between the  
7 ~~spiral windings and shall be four (4) inches internal diameter,~~ and  
8 properly laid at least <sup>one</sup> ~~two~~ (1) feet below the level of the ground  
9 and covered with at least <sup>one</sup> ~~two~~ feet of earth.

10 Section 2. Whenever it shall be necessary to purchase and lay  
11 a service water main along any street an improvement district shall  
12 be created by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland and the  
13 cost of said service water main <sup>and Hydrants for the same</sup> shall be assessed to said district  
14 so formed, as prescribed in chapter 98, Laws of 1911 of the leg-  
15 islature of the State of Washington.

16 Section 3. Whenever an eight (8) inch or ten (10) inch main  
17 shall be purchased or laid along any street in said Town of Kirkland  
18 the Town of Kirkland shall pay the cost thereof over and above the  
19 cost of purchasing and laying a four (4) inch internal diameter, water  
20 main along said street, which cost shall be paid from a fund to be  
21 created for that purpose by the Town of Kirkland under proper  
22 ordinance.
