ORDINANCE NO. /25

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement and grading of Central Avenue from its intersection with Lake Avenue, in a nontheasterly direction up Central Avenue to the center line of Gersay Street with a twenty foot top and a slope of 1 to 1, also with a four foot plank walk on the north side thereof, and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, all in accordance with plans to be prepared by the Town Engineer, all in accordance with Besolution No. 1/1 of the Town Council of the Town OF KIRKLAND, and creating a Local Improvement District for such improvement, and providing that payment for said improvement be made by special assessments upon property in said district, payable by the mode of "Immediate Payment".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND, as follows:

10.

Section 1. That Central Avenue be improved from its intersection with Lake Avenue, in a northeasterly direction up Central Avenue to the center line of Jerset Street, by grading, with a twenty (20) foot top and a slope of 1 to 1, also with a four foot plank side walk on the north side thereof, and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications therefor prepared under the direction of and by the Town Engineer, and on file in the office of the Secretary of the Council of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created, in accordance with law. The Town of Kirkland shall not be liable in any manner for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 4. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be defrayed by special assessments payable by the mode of "Immediate Payment", as defined by law, and the ordinances of the Town of Kirkland. Warrants bearing interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum until paid, shall be issued to the contractor for the redemption of as many of the warrants issued on the Local Improvement District Fund on estimates of the Town Engineer, as may not be redeemed in cash.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and its publication; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become an ordinance inder the law.
