AN ORDINANCE, providing for and regulating and controlling the use of electric wires and connection therewith, and for the safety and protection of the same and of the citizens of the Town of Kirkland, and providing penalties for violations thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND, as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to cut, alter, change, remove, disconnect or connect with or in any way interfere, meddle or tamper with any electric wire, main, meter, cable or conduit owned or used by or in the Town of Kirkland, or by any private person, company or corporation, without first securing the written permission or consent of the light and wire inspector of the Town of Kirkland and filing such consent with the Clerk of said Town.

Section 2. Any person violating or failing to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town jail or the county jail of King County not exceeding twenty (20) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and its publication as required by law.
