ORDINANCE NO. 133

1 AN ORDINANCE, providing for and regulating and controlling the
2 use of electric wires and connection therewith, and for the safety
3 and protection of the same and of the citizens of the Town of
4 Kirkland, and providing penalties for violations thereof.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND, as
6 follows:

7 Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to cut,
8 alter, change, remove, disconnect or connect with or in any way
9 interfere, meddle or tamper with any electric wire, main, meter, cable
10 or conduit owned or used by or in the Town of Kirkland, or by any
11 private person, company or corporation, without first securing the
12 written permission or consent of the light and wire inspector of the
13 Town of Kirkland and filing such consent with the Clerk of said
14 Town.

15 Section 2. Any person violating or failing to comply with any
16 provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor
17 and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in any sum
18 not exceeding Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the
19 Town jail or the county jail of King County not exceeding twenty
20 (20) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion
21 of the court.

22 Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
23 from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and its publica-
24 tion as required by law.
