AN ORDINANCE regulating the use and occupation of and the conduct of persons in and upon streets, avenues, ways, boulevards, drives public places and wharves, and rights of way open to the use of the public, and providing penalties for violations thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND, as follows;

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive or propel/an automobile, auto cycle or other motor vehicle along, over or though any public place, street, boulevard or drive in the Town of Kirkland at a greater rate of speed than ten (10) miles per hour within that certain district in the Town of Kirkland, toowit, within three hundred (300) feet of the water approach to the dock or steamboat landing known as the King County Dock, or at a greater rate of speed than fifteen (15) miles per hour along, on, through or over any other public place within the limits of the Town of Kirkland, or pass or cross any street interestion or round any corner within either of the districts in this section described, at a greater rate of speed than ten (10) miles per hour.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive or propel any automobile, auto cycle or other motor vehicle without having attached thereto a bell, gong, horn or whistle in good working order and sufficient to give warning of the approach of such machine or vehicle, or to fail or neglect to sound such device as a warning when necessary upon approaching any carriage; automobile, auto cycle or other vehicle, or any pedestrian or upon approachinghany street intersection or before passing around any corner on any street or public highway in the Town of Kirkland.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town jail or in the County jail of King County, for a term
