An ordinance providing for the improvement of Piccadilly and other streets, by the laying of water mains, and installation of hydrants thereon, in accordance with resolution No. of the town Council; creating local improvement district therefor, and providing that said improvement be paid for by special assessment upon the property in the district, payable by the mode of immediate payment.

BE IT ORDAINED by the town Council of the Town of Kirkland as follows:

Sec. 1. That a four-inch water main be laid, and fire hydrants installed, on Piccadilly Street East from Oxford Street to the city limits, on Market Street North from Piccadilly St. to Regent Street; along Regent Street to the intersection with Juanita Street, along Juanita Street to the intersection with Spring St., and North on Spring St. to the South line of Lot 10, Block 22, Blewett's Addition to the Town of Kirkland, and South to Spring Street from the intersection with Juanita Street to Fleet Street. That fire hydrants shall be installed and such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications therefor prepared by the town engineer.

Sec. 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with the law.

trict No. \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, which said district is hereby described as follows:

All of the property between the termini of said improvement abutting upon, adjacent, vicinal, or proximate to such portion of said streets and avenues to a distance back to the marginal lines

thereof, as provided by law.

Sec. 4. Local improvement warrants bearing interest at seven percent shall be issued in payment of the costs and expenses for this improvement, which warrants shall be redeemed and paid by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed against the property within theaforesaid district. The said special assessment shall become due and payable immediately upon the confirmation and of the assessment roll, as provided by law.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
