Improvement of Piccadilly Street.

L.I.D. No. 37. Ordinance No. 163.

BOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the assessment roll for Local Improvement District No. 37, under Ordinance No. 163, for the improvement of Piccadilly Street from Market Street East to Oxford Street by the laying of a four-foot wooden sidewalk along the South side thereof, and such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications thereof, prepared under the direction of the town engineer, as now on file at the office of the Town Clerk.

Said assessment roll has been set down for hearing at the meeting of the council to be held at eight o'clock P. M. at the town hall on the 30 day of October, 1916, and all persons who may desire to object to said assessment are notified to make such objections in writing and to file the same with the Town Clerk at or prior to the date fixed for such hearing. At the time and place fixed and at such other times as the hearing may be continued to, the Council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of considering such roll, and at such hearing, or hearings, will consider such objections made thereto, or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify such roll, or any part thereof, or set aside such roll and order that such assessment be made de novo, as to such body shall appear just and Juitable, and then proceed to confirm same by ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Picca-dilly Street East to Oxford Street by the laying of a four-foot board sidewalk along the South side of said Street, and creating local improvement District therefor, and providing for the payment of said improvement by special assessment upon the property in said district, all in accordance with Resolution No. 41 of the Town Obuncil of the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Town Council of the Town of Kirk-land, as follows:

Sec. 1: That Piccadilly Street from Market Street

East to Oxford Street be improved by the laying of a four-foot

board sidewalk along the South side of said Street; and that such

other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith

according to the plans and specifications thereof prepared under

the instruction of the Town Engineer.

Sec. 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created, in accordance with the law.

Sec. 3. That there is hereby established, a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District No. 37, which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to said portion of said street to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law."

Sec. 4. Warrants bearing interest at the rate of seven percent per annum shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which warrants shall be redeemed and paid by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within the Local Improvement District provided for herein, said assessment to be immediately due and payable upon the hearing and confirmation of the assessment roll.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
