ORDINANCE NO. 16>

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Waverly Street from the intersection with Market Street Northwesterly to the Westerly line of Lake Avenue by surfacing and graveling and installing of necessary drains, and creating a local improvement District therefor, and providing for the payment of said improvement by special assessment upon the property in said District, in accordance with Resolution No. 69 of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland.

RE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, as follows:

Sec. 1. That Waverly Street from the intersection with Market Street Northwesterly to the Westerly line of Lake Avenue be improved by surfacing and graveling and installing of necessary drains; and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith, according to the plans and specifications thereof prepared under the direction of the Town Engineer.

Sec. 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created, in accordance with the law.

Sec. 3. That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called Local Improvement District.

No. 40, which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to said portion of said street to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law."
