

An ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Waverly Street and other Streets, and Jefferson Avenue and other Avenues of the Town of Kirkland, and creating a Local Improvement District therefor and providing for the payment for the said improvement by special assessment upon the property in said district, all in accordance with resolution No. 71 of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland as follows:

Sec. 1. That Waverly Street from Market Street west to the west line of Lake Avenue; Richmond Street from Market St. North West to Lake Ave.; Park St. from Richmond St. to Waverly St.; Marion Street ~~from~~ and Lake Ave. from Market St. North west to the Nelson tract; Bold St from Lake Ave. North to Washington Ave.; Oxford St. from Seattle Ave. north to Portland Ave.; Dale St. from Michigan Ave. north to Jefferson Ave.; Jefferson Ave. from Dale St. east to Orchard St.; Orchard St. from Piccadilly north to Arlington Ave.; Seattle Ave. <sup>from Bold St.</sup> east to Oxford St.; Central Ave. ~~from~~ <sup>from</sup> Lake Ave. east to Liverpool St.; Bessemer Ave. from Market St. east to Bold St.; Piccadilly Ave. from Market St. east to Central Ave.; Madison Ave. from Market St. east to Dale St.; and Washington Ave. from Bold St. east to Oxford St. be improved by building the necessary culverts and gravelling the surface nine feet wide and eight inches deep, and that such other work be done as may be necessary in connection therewith according to the plans and specifications thereof prepared under the instruction of the Town Engineer.

Sec. 2. Also by laying a concrete sidewalk <sup>on the (6') wide</sup> on the east side of Lake Ave. From Kirkland Ave north to the north side of Central Ave. thence west along the north side of Lake Ave. to Market St.; on both sides of Market St. from Lake Ave. north to Piccadilly Ave., and from Piccadilly north on the west side of Market St. to the Town limits.

Sec. 3. That the cost and expense of the said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created in accordance with the law.

Sec. 4. That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called ~~the~~ L.I.D. No. 41, which said district is described as follows: "All property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to the said portions of said ~~the~~ streets to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law."

Sec. 5. That warrants bearing interest at the rate of seven percent per annum shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which warrants shall be redeemed and paid by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property ~~in~~ within the Local Improvement District provided for herein, said assessment to be immediately due and payable upon the hearing and confirmation of the assessment roll.

Sec. 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from ~~and~~ <sup>its</sup> passage and publication as provided by law.
