

An ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Bond and other streets by the laying of a four inch water main thereon and installing the necessary hydrants, and creating a local improvement district therefor, and providing for the payment for the said improvement by special assessment upon the property in said district all in accordance with resolution No. 72 of the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, as follows;

Sec. 1. That Bond Street from Market St. west to Lake Ave.; Piccadilly from Market St. east to Oxford St.; Jersey St. from Piccadilly north to Olympia Ave. and from Piccadilly south to Cascade Ave.; Cascade Ave. from Jersey St. east to the east line of Lot 15 Block 169; Orchard St. from Piccadilly North to Massachusetts St.; The State Aid Road from New Hampshire St. south to the south line of Commercial St.; and Third St. from New Hampshire St. south to the south line of Commercial Addition, be improved by laying a four inch water main of wood therein and installing the necessary hydrants, and by doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith according to the plans and specifications therefor prepared under the instruction of the Town Engineer.

Sec. 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement including all necessary incidental expenses shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created, in accordance with the law.

Sec. 3. That there is hereby established a Local Improvement District to be called L.I.D. No. 42, which said district is described as follows:

"All the property between the termini of said improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to said portion of said street to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law"

Sec. 4. Warrants bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this improvement, which shall be redeemed and paid by the collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed upon the property within the Local Improvement District provided for herein, said assessments to be immediately due and payable upon the hearing and confirmation of the assessment roll.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law
