

Ordinance No. 171

An ORDINANCE prohibiting the sale or Fireworks and providing a penalty.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town Of Kirkland as follows;

Sec. 1. That the sale of and use of firecrackers and all kinds of explosives and inflammable articles commonly known as fireworks is hereby prohibited within the Town of Kirkland until the close of the war.

Sec. 2. Any one violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than five, nor more than one hundred dollars.
