ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE Prohibiting Loitering in and about the streets after commonly certain hours, and to be known as a "Curfew" Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town Kirkland:-

Sec. I- That it shall be unlawful for any child or minor under the age of 21 yrs. to loiter in or about any public pool or billiard room or hall, or to be abroad in or upon ^{any} street or public place ^{after} the hour of 9 o'clock P.M. to 7 o'clock A.M. ^{during the months from Oct. 1 to Mar 31} except when accompanied by his or her ~~parent~~ ^{parent} or Guardian, or when engaged in lawful employment.

Sec. II- It shall be unlawful for any Parent or Guardian of any child or minor under the age 21 yrs. to allow or permit such child or minor to loiter in or about any public pool billiard room or hall, or to be abroad after the hour of 9 o'clock P.M. contrary to the provisions of Section I hereof.

Sec. III- It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter upon or about the Ferry Dock, or in or upon any street or public place between the hours from 10 30 P.M. to 5.30 o'clock A.M.

Sec. IV- Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed \$25.00 or imprisoned in jail for a term not exceeding Ten Days.
