An ORDINANCE amending ordinanceNoI76 entitled, an ordinance providing rules and regulations governing the use of city water by the citizens of the Town of Kirkland."

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland Sec.I.That Sec.Is of ordinance No.I76 be and hereby is amended to read as follows.

Sec. 2. The use of water for sprinkling or irrigating lawns, gardens, flower beds, plants, trees, shrubs, or parking strips is hereby prohibited ed except between the hours of 5 to 9 o'clock a.m. and 7 to 9 p.m. No water for sprinkling/pr/irrigating user shall use water for irrigating or sprinkling except through one hose not exceeding three quarters of an inch in dismeter, with a nozzle, the orifice of which is in no case greater than one fourth of an inch in dismeter, or in the place of such nozzle an automatic sprinkler with no greater capacity than a nozzle one fourth of an inch in diameter, and it shall be unlawful for any person to use water for sprinkling or irrigating through any other size of hose, nozzle or sprinkler than as herein prescribed, or through any leaky or defective hose, or throughmore than one set of hose, or through a hose without such nozzle or sprinkler attached at any other time than as herein authorized. Provided the foregoing restrictions shall not apply to a metered service.

It shall be unlawful for any person to use the water for irrigateing or sprinkling during the progress of any fire in town, except for the protection of property against fire.

If any person shall violate any provision of this section, the water Commissioner shall shut off the water furnithed to the premises on

which such violation occursand shall charge one dollar (\$I.00) for again turning the water on, and the Commissioner shall not again turn on the water to such premises until all charges are fully paid.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in operation from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor and its publication.
